



**TAX UPDATE**

Dear Valued Reedy Photo Customers,

Stemming from the U.S. Supreme Court decision in *South Dakota v. Wayfair* in 2018, tax law changes were issued on June 21, 2018 that affect businesses selling and reselling products throughout the United States.

The Court ruled that a state can require an out-of-state seller to collect sales or use tax on sales to customers in that state, even though the seller lacks an in-state physical presence.

Due to these sales tax laws, the number of states where we have sales tax nexus has grown. Although most of the products we sell would be considered tax-exempt, remaining compliant with these expanded laws protects Reedy Photo and You, our customers, from potential tax audits and penalties for products bought from us.

Reedy Photo is required to charge sales tax on all orders for customers for which we do not have a valid resale exemption certificate on file. At this time, we do not have a valid form on file for your company. If we can get these forms prior to your next order, items that should be tax-exempt will continue to be.

Products that are resold or are a component of your sale, should be exempt. All other products are subject to sales tax. Please provide a valid tax exemption certificate or complete and submit the attached documents. Please send certificates to:

If valid forms are not supplied, we are required by law to charge sales tax on all future orders, effective January 1, 2023. We appreciate your help in getting this done now so your future invoices are correct. Don't hesitate to reach out with any questions or concerns.
